




CURRENT POPULATION BREAKDOWN



MONTHLY SECURE CARE POPULATION (Population based on the last day of each month.)





SECURE CARE POPULATION BY COUNTY





SECURE CARE POPULATION BY STATUS






SECURE CARE AGE DISTRIBUTION
