## COVID-19 Visitation Information for Guardians

Adobe Mountain School Families:

The Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections is committed to updating our families as new information comes to light about COVID-19. Your child's health and safety is our top priority. We are continuing to take precautionary steps to protect the youth at Adobe Mountain School from coming into contact with this disease. One of those steps has been to temporarily suspend visitation.

We had previously informed you that youth would begin to receive an increase in weekly phone calls. We are now prepared to begin implementing Video Visitation. Caseworkers and Parole Officers will contact you in an effort to schedule those Video Visitations.

For specific questions, please contact your child's Case Worker.

We urge you to please continue to practice healthy hygiene habits and prevent the spread of COVID-19 by:

- Washing your hands throughout the day with soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth, and nose.
- Cover your cough and sneeze with a tissue or with your elbow or shoulder.
- Staying home when you are sick.
- Disinfecting common spaces and surfaces.
